1 THE COURT: OKAY. 2 MR. MOORE: I FILED OBJECTIONS TO YOU PRESIDING OVER THESE PROCEEDINGS. 3 4 THE COURT: I'VE NOT SEEN THOSE. 5 MR. MOORE: YOU HAVEN'T SEEN THOSE. THE COURT: NO. WERE THEY FILED IN THE CASE? 6 7 MR. MOORE: YES. WELL, I FILED THEM LAST NIGHT. 8 MAYBE THEY HAVE NOT COME FROM THE CLERK. 9 THE COURT: THEY HAVE NOT. THEY HAVE NOT MADE 10 THEIR WAY. 11 MR. MOORE: I HAVE A COPY. 12 THE COURT: I CANNOT LET -- I CANNOT OPINE ON WHETHER THOSE OBJECTIONS ARE TIMELY. TYPICALLY, AT THIS 13 POINT IN THE PROCEEDING, THEY ARE NOT. MOORE: THE REASON --18 THE COURT: I'M SPEAKING RIGHT NOW. 19 WE WILL PROCEED IN THE INTERIM AND LET'S GO 20 AHEAD. 21 MR. MOORE: I HAVE ANOTHER ISSUE, TOO, YOUR 22 HONOR. 23 THE COURT: YES. WHAT ELSE? 24 MR. MOORE: THE OTHER THING IS I OBJECT TO THIS 25 SO-CALLED ATTORNEY OVER HERE --26 THE COURT: MR. TALEI. 27 MR. MOORE: -- REPRESENTING ANYBODY, ESPECIALLY A 28 TRUSTEE IN THIS TRUST. YOU HAVE SEEN HIM, YOU WITNESSED

1 HIM LYING IN THIS COURT UNDER OATH IN HIS TESTIMONY. 2 THE COURT: FIRST OF ALL, MR. MOORE, YOU NEED TO KEEP YOUR VOICE -- YOU NEED TO KEEP YOUR VOICE DOWN. 3 4 YOU CANNOT GET ARGUMENTATIVE AND VEXATIOUS LIKE THAT. 5 I HAVE NOT WITNESSED MR. TALEI 6 MISREPRESENTING ANYTHING AT ALL IN THESE PROCEEDINGS. 7 AND IT WOULD NOT BE WITHIN THIS COURT'S POWER -- TELL ME AGAIN, YOUR REQUEST WAS, WHAT WAS YOUR REQUEST? 8 9 MR. MOORE: WELL, TO --10 THE COURT: GO AHEAD. MR. MOORE: MAY I SPEAK? 11 THE COURT: YES. 12 MR. MOORE: TO PUT IT SHORT, I HAVE FIRED HIM 13 UNDER PROCESS OF CRIMINAL LAW. 14 15 THE COURT: YOU HAVE --16 MR.
